

**THE HIGHWAYS AGENCY  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984  
THE M62 MOTORWAY  
(JUNCTION 34, WHITLEY)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Transport intends to make an Order on the M62 Motorway, in the District of Selby, to enable carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out in safety.

The works are expected to commence on Monday 2 August 2010 and take place over 4 nights, or until completed, between 8pm and 6am.

The effect of the Order will be to close, at times during the works, the M62 eastbound and westbound exit and entry slip roads at Junction 34 (Whitley).

Traffic signs will indicate the extent of the prohibitions (which will not apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles being used in connection with the said works or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes). The Order comes into force on 1 August 2010 and has a maximum duration of eighteen months.

When the eastbound entry slip road is closed, traffic will be diverted via the A19, the A645, the A1041 and finally the A614 to access the M62 at Junction 36 (Airmyn). When the eastbound exit slip road is closed, traffic will continue eastbound to change carriageways at Junction 36 and return westbound to exit at Junction 34. When the westbound entry slip road is closed, traffic will be diverted westwards on Whitefield Lane/Cobcroft Lane, northwards on Beal Lane/Sudforth Lane, westwards on the A645, and finally on the A1(M) southbound at Holmfield Interchange to access the M62 at Junction 33 (Ferrybridge). When the westbound exit slip road is closed, traffic will continue westbound to change carriageways at Junction 33 and return eastbound to exit at Junction 34.

This Order is in conjunction with Local Authority prohibitions proposed to be in force during the works on the A19 Whitley Interchange Roundabout.
